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How to Password-Protect Your Excel 2019 File - dummies

How to unprotect Excel Workbook and Worksheet with or without password. To protect the data from unauthorized reading or editing by others, we set protection password on the Excel workbook, workbook structure or worksheet. However, when we forget the protected password, we can't read or edit the data on the Excel file too.

Protect a worksheet - Excel

For Excel 2019/2017/2016/2013/2010, click on "Protect Workbook" and select "Encrypt with Password" from the drop-down list. (For Excel 2007 and older versions, click on "Protect Document" and select "Encrypt with Password")

Recover lost worksheet protection password in Excel with VBA code. The following VBA code can help you to quickly cancel your original passwords in a worksheet. 1. Open your worksheet which has been protected before. 2. Hold down the ALT + F11 keys, and it opens the Microsoft Visual Basic for Applications window.

Method #3: Unprotect Excel Workbook Structure using VBA Step 1. Firstly, you need to open an your password protected excel workbook, then Press Alt+F11 to launch VBA Editor window. Step 2. Insert a Module for Insert Menu, then copy all code below and Paste in the code window of VBA editor.

Select File > Info. Select the Protect Workbook box and choose Encrypt with Password. Enter a password in the Password box, and then select OK. Confirm the password in the Reenter Password box, and then select OK.

Password protecting an Excel workbook at the file level controls access in two ways: It lets a user in, and it lets a user save changes.

3 Ways to Unprotect Excel Workbook Structure without Password

To control the level of access users should have to an Excel file, use file-level protection. To control how users should work with worksheets inside a your workbook's structure, use workbook-level protection. To control how users should work within an individual worksheet, use worksheet-level protection.

Require a password to open or modify a workbook - Excel ...

Protect 1. Open a workbook. 2. On the File tab, click Save As. 3. Click Browse. 4. Click on the Tools button and click General Options. 5. In the Password to open box, enter a password and click OK. 6. Reenter the password and click OK. 7. Enter a file name and click Save.

How to Protect Cells, Sheets, and Workbooks in Excel

Protecting a workbook. Follow these steps to protect an Excel 2007 workbook: Click the Protect Workbook command button in the Changes group on the Review tab. Excel opens the Protect Structure and Windows dialog box, where the Structure check box is selected by default.

3 Ways to Password Protect a Workbook/Sheet in Excel 2016-2007

While working in Excel, navigate to the File tab choose the Info tab. Click on the Protect Workbook dropdown option and choose Encrypt with Password. As is the case with any password, choose a strong and secure combination of letters, numbers, and characters, bearing in mind that passwords are case-sensitive.

Notes: Unlike workbook element protection, which prevents changes to the structure and windows of a workbook, workbook-level password security helps protect the entire file against unwanted changes.. Open the document that you want to help protect.

VBA Workbook Protection (Password Protect / Unprotect ...

The way to enable password protection to protect a workbook structure and lock a spreadsheet is similar to Excel 2010 -2016. While there is a slight difference to put an opening password on a workbook in Excel 2007.

Password Protect Excel Workbook

If you want to add a password to a workbook you are working on in Excel for the web, and you have Excel desktop application, you can use the Open in Excel button to open the workbook and password protect the workbook. But going forward, you'll only be able to make changes to the workbook in Excel desktop application.

How to unprotect Excel Workbook and Worksheet with or ...

VBA Workbook Protection allows you to lock the structure of the workbook. When a workbook is protected, users will be unable to add, delete, hide / unhide, or protect / unprotect worksheets. If you are building a model, you probably want to turn on workbook protection to prevent users (or you!) from accidentally deleting worksheets.

Protection and security in Excel - Office Support

To unprotect a sheet, follow these steps: Go to the worksheet you want to unprotect. Go to File > Info > Protect > Unprotect Sheet, or from the Review tab > Changes > Unprotect Sheet. If the sheet is protected with a password, then enter the password in the Unprotect Sheet dialog box, and click OK.
